### **Waste**

- Efforts to reduce food wastage
- Single-use plastic stirrers not used
- Single-use plastic straws not used
- Single-use plastic beverage bottles not used
- Single-use plastic cups not used
- Single-use plastic cutlery/plates not used

### **Water**

- Water-efficient toilets
- Water-efficient showers
- Option to opt-out of daily room cleaning
- Option to reuse towels

### **Energy and greenhouse gases**

- Most food provided at the property is locally sourced
- Most lighting throughout property uses energy-efficient LED bulbs
- All windows are double-glazed
- Offsets a portion of their carbon footprint
- Key card or motion-controlled electricity

### **Destination and community**

- Invests a percentage of revenue back into community projects or sustainability projects
- Local artists are offered a platform to display their talents

- Provides guests with information regarding local ecosystems, heritage and culture, as well as visitor etiquette

## **Nature**

- Wild (non-domesticated) animals are not displayed/interacted with while captive on the property or harvested, consumed, or sold.
